The 2005-2006 season saw over 3,000 hockey fans pass through the doors of Bladez on Ice to witness the Pirates produce an incredible 7-1 home record. Greenville embraced the sport of hockey with the help of several articles in *The Daily Reflector*, and *The East Carolinian*, as well as interviews and features on PirateRadio 1250&930, WITN 7, WNCT 9 and WFXI 8. As an organization we receive a small amount of funding from the university and must rely heavily upon local sponsorships and player dues to pay for our various expenses. The club has maintained a positive public image and continues to do so through various means such as volunteering and support of local non-profit organizations.

Here is a recap of the 2005-2006 season both on and off the ice:

- First game: 3-1 victory over Virginia Commonwealth University at Richmond, VA
- First home game: 4-3 victory over Radford University with estimated attendance of 350
- First playoff game: 5-2 victory over Virginia Military Institute at Wilmington, NC
- Average season attendance: approximately 450
- Season high attendance: approximately 675 for 4-2 victory over UNC-Chapel Hill
- Live play-by-play provided by PirateRadio 1250&930 for 14-4 victory over UNC-Wilmington
- Regular season record: 14-7 overall, 11-5 in BRHC play, #8 in ACHA South Region (out of 28 teams)
- 2-1 record at Blue Ridge Hockey Conference Playoffs, finished 2nd overall
- 2 players named to All-Conference Second Team
- Over 100 Booster Club members receive E-Newsletter
- Volunteer coaches for Bladez on Ice youth hockey league
- Special guests at St. Peter's Catholic School event
- Helped raise money for the REAL Crisis Center as special guests at their Skate for REAL event held at Bladez on Ice

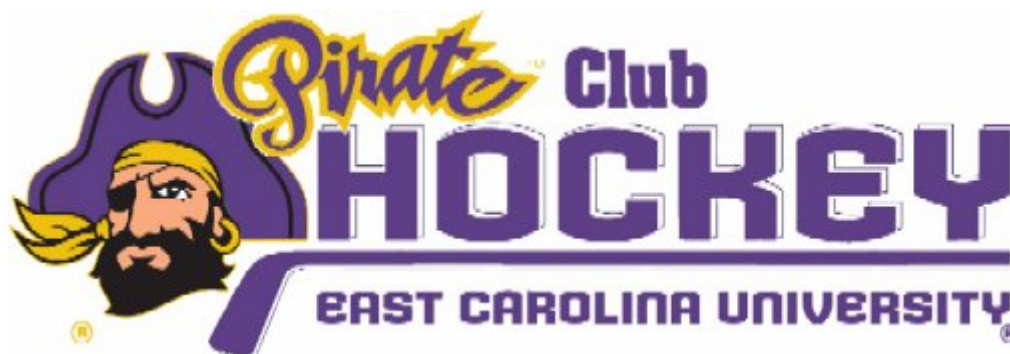
